The 2nd project is also a landed property which had a smaller roof which was approximately 64 square meters in size. The owner's main objective was also to have his electricity bills covered and to go green. The rest of the details are listed here:

Agreement Confirmation November 2014
System Size Approx 9.6kWp
Potential/Projected Savings Approx S\$3,000/year *
